Application Process

- Apply through OUAC by January 15
 - only one U of T Engineering choice
 - Can select up to 4 programs on the Online Student Profile – will be considered for admission in order specified
- Complete mandatory Online Student Profile
 - Deadline: February 1
 - Early Deadline: December 15 (for consideration in Feb)
- Submit proof of English Facility or required documents
 - Deadline: February 1



Engineering Applicant Portal

- Engineering applicants check the status of their application through the Engineering Applicant Portal
- Applicants access their mandatory online Student Profile through the Portal
- Any required documents or requests for special consideration must be submitted through the Portal

Offer Timing

- Decisions are made in 3 rounds:
 - February:
 - must complete application by December 15
 - Considered only for first choice Engineering program
 - March & May:
 - Complete application by February 1
 - Consideration for all programs listed on OSP
 - Approximately 40% of offers are made in May



Scholarships

- Applicants are automatically considered for scholarships in each round and reconsidered in May
- University wide scholarships
- Faculty Scholarships
 - Considered based on academics and extra-curricular activities as demonstrated on online Student Profile
 - Most departments also have scholarships



Need Based Admission Awards

- For domestic Ontario high school students considered based on:
 - Financial need
 - Academic achievement
 - Extra-curricular involvement
- To be eligible applicants must submit UTAPS application by February
 - Access link through Engineering Applicant Portal
