

# **Exit Counselling Verification Form**

## **Instructions:**

- 1. Complete Exit counselling online: <a href="https://studentloans.gov/myDirectLoan/index.action">https://studentloans.gov/myDirectLoan/index.action</a>.
- 2. Read and complete form and return it to Enrolment Services.

# **Rights and Responsibilities:**

#### I understand that I have the right to the following:

- Written information on loan obligations, including loan consolidation and information on my rights and responsibilities
- A copy of my Master Promissory Note either before or at the time my loan is disbursed;
- A grace period and an explanation of what this means;
- Notification if the Department transfers your loan to another servicer without your consent;
- A disclosure statement, received before I begin to repay my loan, that includes information about interest rates, fees, the balance I owe, and a loan repayment schedule;
- Deferment or forbearance of repayment for certain defined periods, if I qualify and if I request it;
- Prepay my loan in whole or in part anytime without an early-repayment penalty; and
- Documentation when my loan is paid in full.

## I understand that I am required to do the following:

- Completing exit counseling before I leave school or drop below half-time enrollment;
- Repay my loan according to my repayment schedule even if I do not complete my academic program, I am dissatisfied with the education I received, or I am unable to find employment after I graduate;
- Notify my lender or loan servicer if I:
  - o Move or change my address,
  - o Change my telephone number,
  - o Change my name,
  - o Change my Social Security number, or
  - o Change employers or my employer's address or telephone number changes;
- Make monthly payments on my loan after my grace period ends, unless I have a deferment or forbearance;
- Notify my lender or loan servicer of anything that might alter my eligibility for an existing deferment or forbearance.

I understand that counselors are available in the Financial Aid Office to answer any questions I may have about the loans. I understand that completing the instructions above certifies that I have met my obligation to participate in exit counseling as prescribed by federal statute.
