

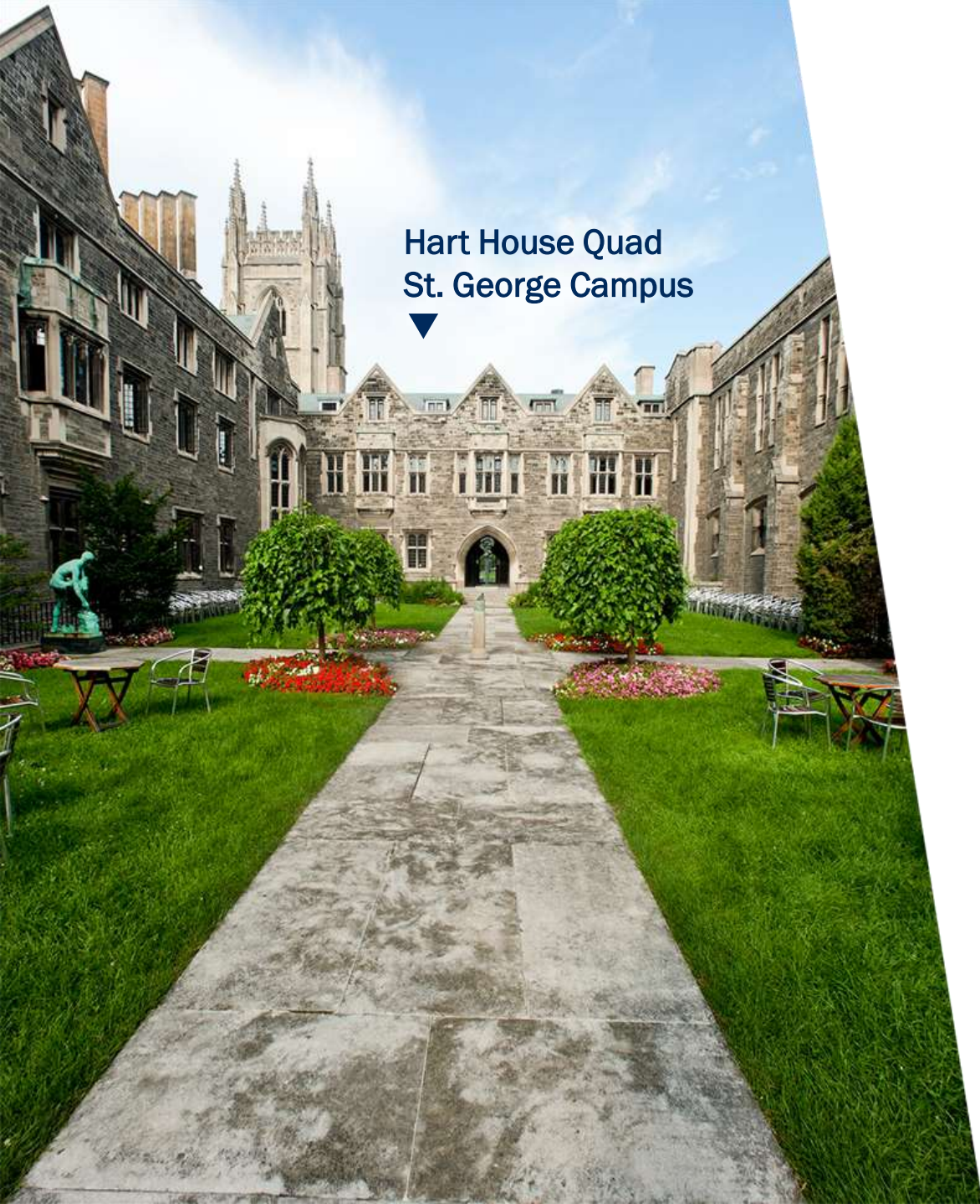

## **SAT/ACT Test Optional for Fall 2021**

NEW - Test optional assessment has been adopted for students applying for Fall 2021 admission.

Students who cannot or choose not to submit test results will not be disadvantaged in the admissions process; however, students who have written SAT or ACT tests previously, and wish to have these considered in their assessment, are encouraged to submit their scores. Students seeking admission to science or commerce/management programs are strongly advised to complete AP Calculus. Students aiming for admission in Fall 2022 should visit this page in early Fall 2021 to view up-to-date requirements for their cohort.

## **Optional Provincial/Diploma Exams for Fall 2021**

While Canadian secondary schools and provincial Ministries of Education are adjusting their evaluation methods, grading processes, or using alternative methods of assessment, such adjustments will not negatively affect admission consideration.

In jurisdictions where Diploma/Provincial exams are now optional, when considering an applicant's final results for Fall 2021 admission, we will use the final mark on a transcript whether a Diploma/Provincial exam was written or not.

# SUBMITTING DOCUMENTS

Applicant Status Portal:


Required documents are listed based on the applicant's educational system.

- ▶ Submitting academic documents:
  - ▶ Student Manual Document Upload via JOIN U of T
  - ▶ Parchment (Cialfo, BridgeU, Maia Learning, Unifrog), Naviance, OUAC, SCOIR
  - ▶ Mailing Documents: if uploading or electronic transfer of documents is not possible
- ▶ School Counsellors Submission Form for Report Cards/Transcripts (**<https://uoft.me/counselloruploadform>**)
  - ▶ For schools to submit transcripts ONLY if electronic submission is unavailable to school or if school will not release transcripts to their students.
  - ▶ This Form is NOT for students to use.

# RECOMMENDATIONS FROM ENROLMENT SERVICES

- ▶ Apply early and submit all the required documents early!
  - ▶ Documents must be uploaded or sent electronically.
    - ▶ We cannot accept documents as email attachments.
  - ▶ Multiple page transcripts should be uploaded as one file and must be legible - all pages (front and back).
  - ▶ If Self-Reported Form is part of applicant's checklist, it is **MANDATORY**
    - ▶ FAQs are linked on the student's portal

# RECOMMENDATIONS FROM ENROLMENT SERVICES

- ▶ Test scores, including TOEFL and IELTS, must be sent electronically by the testing service; paper results are not acceptable.
  - ▶ AP exam results should come directly from College Board for transfer credit
  - ▶ Encourage students to read ALL instructions carefully!

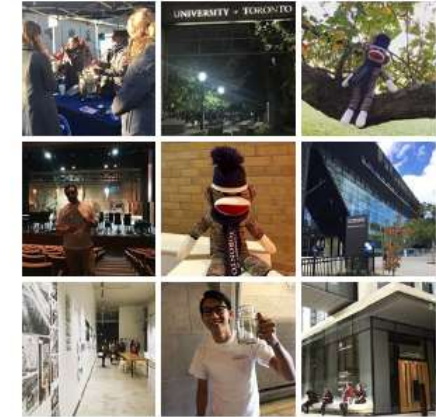

## Tips on Uploading Documents

- All uploaded transcripts are considered **unofficial**. Transcripts sent to Enrolment Services electronically via Parchment/Naviance, the OUAC electronic delivery system, and the IBO are considered official. Transcripts sent to Enrolment Services in a sealed envelope directly from an institution are also considered official. **Do not mail us official records unless they are requested.**
- Multiple page transcripts should be uploaded as one file and must be **legible, complete, and virus-free**. Scan both sides of your document(s); grading scales are usually found on the reverse.
- **Do not** mail or fax the documents that you have uploaded. **DO NOT** upload documents that have already been sent electronically (e.g. via Parchment/Naviance, OUAC electronic submissions, etc.). Submitting multiple copies of the same documents will delay the application process.
- **DO NOT upload or mail** unsolicited documents such as reference letters, resumes, and achievement certificates. Such documents will not be reviewed or added to your record.
- Once you have uploaded a document, view it by clicking on '**Preview**'. If the document you have uploaded is illegible, incomplete, or incorrect, you can upload the correct document by clicking on '**Add another**'.
